### CONSERVATION

- **8,600** hours of research conducted by **325** people to support the development and success of restoration and management plans for Canada's water.
- Rescued and repatriated over **15,000** fish to protect threatened populations, brought back locally extinct populations and brought awareness to the importance of native fish species.
- Planted over **13,500** trees fighting climate change, improving air and water quality.
- Repaired over **25** kilometres of Canada's streams and rivers, increasing animal habitat, and protecting and enhancing fish populations while drastically improving water quality and battling climate change.

### EDUCATION

- Educated over **60,000**, improving knowledge and awareness on water quality and stream restoration.
- Empowered over **180** Canadian communities

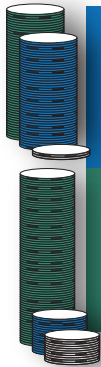
## ADVOCACY
