GENERAL UPDATE

IN REFLECTION

Conserving, Protecting & Restoring Canada's Freshwater

CONSERVATION

- Over 15,000 hours of assessment, planning, and implementation of conservation programming to improve the health, function, and management of Canadian freshwater ecosystems"
- Rescued 72,055 wild fish from southern Alberta irrigation canals returning them to their home rivers and reservoirs.
- Continued to fight climate change, improve air, and water quality, and enhance shoreline habitats by planting over 4000 trees and shrubs.
- Reconnected nearly 3 km of stream by replacing a set of hanging culverts with an open-bottom arch.
- Removed over 2500 lbs. of trash from streams and shorelines, including over 2600 cigarette butts, protecting vulnerable fish and wildlife species, and improving water quality.
- Removed invasive plants from over 31,000 m2 of shoreline area, making space for native plants and biodiversity.

EDUCATION

- Continued educating Canadians of all ages through a variety of programs improving knowledge and awareness regarding pollution, water quality, and stream restoration.
- Since 1998, educated over 130,000 individuals through our Yellow Fish Road program, marking over 70,000 storm drains across Canada.

ADVOCACY

TUC aided in public awareness of critical issues through the dissemination information critical of on issues affecting water quality and aquatic communities. TUC continued to engage with the federal Department of Fisheries and Oceans Canada on the Fish and Fish Habitat Protection Program.
