CONSERVATION

- Dedicated **10,000** hours of research conducted by over **315** people to support the development and success of restoration and management plans for Canada's water.
- Rescued and repatriated **17,000** fish across Canada to protect threatened fish, brought back locally extinct populations and brought awareness to the importance of native fish species.
- Planted over **3,000** trees fighting climate change, improving air and water quality.
- Repaired over **50** kilometres of Canada's streams and rivers, increasing animal habitat, and protecting and enhancing fish populations while drastically improving water quality and battling climate change.

EDUCATION

- Educated over **58,000** people through our national education programming improving knowledge and awareness in non-point source pollution, water quality and stream restoration.
- Engaged **160** partners and education leaders enabling and empowering over **300** local communities across Canada.
- Provided **650** presentations, talks and tours, interacting with **16,500** people, engaging and empowering Canadians to take ownership of their local waters.

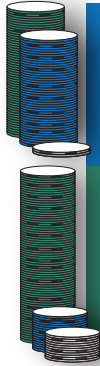
ADVOCACY
